

# Skywarn Full Alert Script

**(Condition Red!)**

(Remember to speak slowly and clearly)

*Start*

Attention all Stations. This is your call Kent County Skywarn Net Control.

The National Weather Service has issued a type of watch or warning for Kent County until (*Expiration Time*)

This Skywarn Net has been upgraded to full alert status. Check-ins will not be taken at this time; only reports of severe weather will be taken from any stations, whether or not you have already checked into this net.

If any of the following threatening conditions are observed in your area, please call your call, Kent County Skywarn Net Control

**Winds in excess of 50 MPH**  
**Hail of any size**  
**Wall Clouds**  
**Tornadoes**  
**Funnel Clouds**  
**Flash Flooding**  
**Any Storm Related Damage**

Please do not report conditions of lower magnitude, as this ties up the repeater for those spotters with more important information.

*(Please remind Spotters the first couple of times to report information in Time Event Location)*

If a repeater failure occurs, the Alternate Kent County Skywarn Net Frequency is 145.410 - with a 94.8 CTCSS tone. This is your call, Kent County Skywarn Net Control.
