

# Skywarn Stand-By Script

(**Condition Yellow!**)

(Remember to speak slowly and clearly)

*Start (repeat every 15 minutes or as conditions dictate):*

Attention all Stations. This is your call Kent County Skywarn Net Control. The purpose of this net is to take spotter Check in's for the Kent County Yellow Mode Net.

A type of watch or warning has been issued for Kent County until (*Expiration Time*) currently, we are in a yellow mode taking spotter check in's. The Sheriff's Department has requested a formal Skywarn Yellow Net at this time.

*If a current radar summary is available:* The current radar image shows (*Radar Summary*)

Weather bulletins will be read every 15 minutes, or as conditions dictate. If any of the following threatening conditions are observed in your area, please call your call, Kent County Skywarn Net Control Operator:

**Winds in excess of 50 MPH**  
**Hail of any size**  
**Wall Clouds**  
**Tornadoes**  
**Funnel Clouds**  
**Flash Flooding**  
**Storm Related Damage**

If a repeater failure occurs, the Alternate Kent County Skywarn Net Frequency is 145.410 - with a 94.8 CTCSS tone.

I will now take check-ins for the Kent County Skywarn Yellow Mode Net. Please remember when checking into this net, to give your Call sign, name, and location slowly. I will acknowledge each station individually. Please call your call, Net Control.

*Take as many check-ins as possible and then stand-by. Enter each check-in into a station log; include call sign, name, location, and time.*

This is your call, Kent County Skywarn Stand-By Net Control standing by and listening.
