

Kent County ARPSC Weekly Net Script

Note: Before starting a net, make sure the repeater is not in use (announce the net five minutes prior to the start of the net) and is reliable. If it is not reliable, let everyone know to go to an alternative repeater.

Please have all stations check in on portable and mobile / Base from there location. Record the signal strength and email details to info@kcraces.org

(Remember to speak slowly and clearly and have fun)

Good evening and welcome to the weekly net of the Kent County Amateur Radio Public Service Corps. The Kent County ARPSC is the Emergency Communications Arm of the Kent County Emergency Service Team. Some ARRL District Staff are regular check-ins to this net. My name is your name and my call sign is your call. I will be the net control this evening. This Net is a directed ARES/RACES net.

When checking into this net, give your call sign and name slowly.

Anyone with an announcement, please call now. *(Repeat as many times as you need to get all the announcements and write down the names and call signs of the individuals with announcements.)*

(After all individuals are checked in for announcements, go back through the list and call upon each individual so that they can make their announcements. Advise them that they are considered checked in.)

Tonight's topic *(or training event)* is: your topic or training event

I will now begin to take check-ins. When checking into this net, give your call sign and name slowly. All check-ins are welcomed.

Mobile or short time stations are invited to call now. *(Repeat as many times as you need to get all the check ins, as you go, write down the names and call signs of the individuals who are checking in Take comments Take two or so then have them give the report. REMEMBER, they are on short time... at the breaks, remember to ask again for any short timers.*

Fixed or mobile stations are invited to call now. *(Repeat as many times as you need to get all the check-in's, as you go, write down the names and call signs of the individuals who are checking in Remember to break every five check ins or so and let them give their comments.) At the breaks, ask again for short time or mobile check-in's*

(Give your comments for the net. Make any announcements as required of you for the next meeting or training event or public service event on the schedule)
